Who: U.S. applicants to the ECE graduate program are automatically considered for the Bradley Fellowship. Underrepresented minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.

What:

MS degree fellowships:

- ◆ \$2,700/month + tuition for two years.

Direct-PhD Fellowship:

- ◆ \$2,800/month + tuition for two years, automatically considered for Bradley PhD Fellowship on completion of MS degree.

PhD degree fellowships:

- ◆ \$3,200/month + tuition for three years.

Postdoctoral fellowships:

- ◆ Competitive salary for two years.
